

## BOONE COUNTY OPEN DAIRY SHOW (Purebred, Grade, and Commercial)

Lebanon, Indiana  
Thursday, July 24, 2008, 9:00 a.m.

THE BOONE COUNTY OPEN DAIRY SHOW COMMITTEE invites you to participate in the Boone County all-breed Open Show to be held on Thursday, July 24, 2008. The show will be held in the Show Arena at the Boone County 4-H Fairgrounds, located along I-65 at Exit 138 at Lebanon. The show will start at 9:00 a.m. promptly. The cattle are to be in place by 8:00a.m.

1. This show is open to any dairy breeder, 4-H dairy member, FFA club member, or anyone with purebred, grade or commercial dairy cattle within or out of the State of Indiana.
2. Cattle from the breeds of Holstein, Guernsey, Brown Swiss, Ayrshire, Jersey, Milking Shorthorn and Commercial dairy cross are eligible for exhibit. Grade and registered animals will show together in class. Commercial dairy is defined as a crossbred offspring of recognized dairy breeds. Junior calves born after March 1, 2008 are eligible.
3. Rosettes will be awarded to the following:  
  - Junior and Senior Champion Females
  - Reserve Junior and Senior Champion Females
  - Reserve Grand Champion Females
 Plaques will be awarded to the Grand Champion Females. There will be no bull classes.
4. Premier Exhibitor Award - a rosette and a \$10 award will be made in each breed to the exhibitor receiving the highest number of points earned in all classes, except championships and best uddered females. Scoring for this award will be as follows:

5. Ribbons will be awarded to 10 places on all classes. Champion and reserve champion rosette ribbons will be awarded in the champion female classes. Also rosettes will be awarded to Reserve Grand Champion females. Ribbons to be given to 3 places on Best Uddered class.
6. Certificates of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) are not required, per Board of Animal Health regulations. However, all animals will be visually inspected for signs of communicable disease. Any animal deemed unhealthy for any reason will not be allowed to unload from the trailer and cannot participate in the show.
7. No cattle may be tied in cattle barns before 10:00 p.m. on July 23, 2008.

8. Entries along with entry fee should be mailed to Mrs. Wendy Tommas-Dolick, 4076 N. 350 W., Thorntown, IN 46071 on or before July 5, 2008. Early entry fees of \$4.00 per animal for all exhibitors must accompany the entry. Entries postmarked after July 5, 2008 until day of show will be \$5.00 per animal.

Early entries are appreciated! Make check payable to **Boone County Dairy Promoters**.

9. Exhibitors may show as many animals as they want but will be paid for only two animals in individual classes.

10. Championships will be selected from all first-place females. Second place animals will be considered at the discretion of the judge.

11. Premiums of \$11-9-7-5-3 are offered in all female classes except Best Uddered Class. If there are 3 or less animals per class, premiums will be halved - \$5.50, \$4.50, \$3.50
