

OPEN MARKET HOG SHOW

Show Date - July 23, 2008 Place - Boone County Fairgrounds

Show Time - 10:00 am
Entry Fee: \$5 per head

General Show Information

1. The show is open to any exhibitor; market barrows and gilts are both eligible for entry.
2. Classes will be divided by weights; barrows and gilts, crossbreds and purebreds will all show together.
2. All entries must be in place by 9:00 AM on Wednesday, July 23. Show will start at 10:00 AM.
3. A market hog shall be defined as a gilt or barrow being produced and raised for slaughter purposes. All market hogs must have been farrowed after January 1, 2008 in order to be eligible for the show.
4. 4-H weights will be used for open show classes. Only hogs not exhibited at the 4-H Swine Show need to be weighed.
5. Trucking and marketing will be available for persons wanting to sell hogs. Market prices will be posted at the scales.
6. Hogs must weigh at least 200 lbs.

PRE-4-H CLASS

1. Contest open to any non-4-H child age 6 to 9 years old during calendar year.
2. Contestant should secure their own pig, but must have health papers. Pork Producers can assist in securing a pig if necessary.
3. All participants will be awarded a ribbon upon completion.
