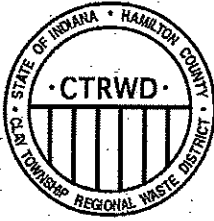


SANITARY SEWER SERVICE AVAILABILITY

The accompanying document is the so called "Will Serve" letter issued by the District Engineer of the Clay Township Regional Waste District (CTRWD) expressing CTRWD's willingness and ability to serve the Project site, subject to its Board of Trustees' approval. Shortly after the Will Serve letter was issued (April 20, 2007) Developer was advised that the CTRWD Board had voted affirmatively to adopt the Project site into CTRWD's service district. The exact route by which sanitary service will be provided to the Project site is still being discussed by CTRWD and the Project's engineers.

To Whom It May Concern:

In response to your recent request, this letter is to advise you that the District has determined that the project mentioned above is located outside the District's current service area and this will serve is contingent upon the Board of Trustees approval to adopt this territory into the District. In addition, sewer capacity exists and facilities are available to provide sanitary sewer service for this project which will be subject to all District ordinances, construction, and inspection requirements.

This project will be required to extend our existing 8" sewers North along US 421 from Interactive Academy in order to provide service. This flow will ultimately be directed through the Brittany Chase Subdivision into lift station 14 which pumps wastewater to the District's Michigan Road Wastewater Treatment Plant.

This letter shall not be construed as approval of any plans for the project. It will be at the sole discretion of the developer to extend sewers to connect this project to the District's existing sewer.
